

## Mr Doug Smith APM

### Chief Executive Officer, CrimTrac

Mr Doug Smith is the Chief Executive Officer of CrimTrac. CrimTrac is a national information-sharing service for Australia's police, law enforcement and national security agencies.

CrimTrac enables vital policing information to be shared between Australia's state, territory and federal police agencies. The four key information services that CrimTrac delivers are the:

- National Automated Fingerprint Identification System
- National Criminal Investigation DNA Database
- Australian National Child Offender Register
- National Police Reference System



Mr Smith's policing career commenced in 1973 with the Victoria Police Service, where he performed a range of policing duties including traffic officer, detective and prosecutor.

He became an Inspector with the Queensland Police Service in 1990 and went on to manage the Fitzgerald Implementation Unit in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner. In 1998 he became the Assistant Commissioner of the Northern Territory Police, Fire and Emergency Services.

Since then he has worked in the Solomon Islands as a Consultant with the Royal Solomon Islands Police Force, and consulted for the Northern Territory Ombudsman on Police Force and Public Sector compliance and performance.

Mr Smith has obtained a Masters of Public Administration (1994) and a Bachelor of Arts with a major in Public Administration and Government and a major in History (1993).

Throughout his career, Mr Smith has received a number of professional commendations and medals for service. These awards include:

- Police Overseas Service Medal (Solomon Islands – 2009),
- Australian Federal Police Commissioner's Group Citation for Hazardous Overseas Service (Solomon Islands – 2006),
- Bar to the Australian National Medal for Long Service and Good Conduct (2000),
- Australian Police Medal for distinguished service to the Queensland Police Service (1995).
